Subject: FY 2019 HOPE Private and Zell Miller Scholarship Program Regulations Correction

On November 5, 2018 GSFC released the HOPE Scholarship for Private Institutions and Zell Miller Scholarship Program Regulations with a revision to the Per Credit Hour Awards sections. However, the version posted included an inaccurate change. Accordingly, the regulations are being revised to reflect the original award information from the July 1, 2018 release.

For FY 2018-2019, eligible institutions may award students that reach the Attempted-Hours and/or the Combined Paid-Hours limit the per credit hour award amount for HOPE or Zell Miller Scholarship based on the original award amounts released in May 2018 (effective July 1) or the amounts released in November 2018. We encourage eligible institutions to use the version most advantageous to the student. An institution is not required to change a disbursement or planned award as a result of this update. The currently active regulations are listed below.

2018-2019 HOPE Scholarship at Private Institutions
Per Credit Hour Awards section 208.4.2

- For a student Enrolled Full-Time (12 or more hours) during a term in which he or she reaches the Attempted-Hours and/or the Combined Paid-Hours limit such student can receive payment only for hours up to the limit.

- For a student Enrolled Full-Time (12 or more hours) during a term in which he or she reaches the Attempted-Hours and/or the Combined Paid-Hours limit such student can only receive payment for hours up to the limit.
