Subject: FY 2022 Program Regulations Revisions

Dear Colleague:

The following is information regarding a revision to the 2021-2022 (FY 2022) Dual Enrollment Program Regulations. The Georgia Student Finance Commission (GSFC) Board approved the revision to the Program Regulations at their board meeting on August 27, 2021. The revision is effective immediately.

2020-2021 Dual Enrollment Program

Revised – Length of Eligibility

- Revised the length of eligibility to include an age limit.
 - A student cannot be older than twenty-one (21) years of age on the start date of the postsecondary term of enrollment for which Dual Enrollment funding is sought.
